At Emergence, we build educational programs that develop the next generation of socially and environmentally conscious leaders and an ecosystem of partnerships and funding to catalyze and scale impactful innovations and companies.

### Emergence Accelerator for Stanford Students

The Emergence Accelerator Program supports a cohort of highly driven social and environmental student entrepreneurs and ventures each year from across campus. Through key impact entrepreneurship workshops, coaching from successful founders, one-on-one mentorship from industry professionals, and facilitated networking and connections to prospective funders, students are supported to ideate, develop, and launch purpose driven ventures that address our most pressing health challenges.

### What is it like to be an Industry Mentor?

We look for individuals and organizations (companies, VC's, successful entrepreneurs, NGO's, Stanford faculty/alumni) who are excited about supporting our student entrepreneurs to develop and launch impact driven ventures. Our industry mentors commit to:

- Meet with 1-5+ students over the course of a 6 month period, based on their interest and availability. Each student commitment is a one time 30-60min meeting (virtual or in-person). Prior to the meeting, the student will share their pitch deck and 1-3 key area(s) they would like to solicit input based on expertise and topical alignment.
- Share your experiences and encourage students on their path to success.
- Provide critical feedback to students to refine their venture pitch, business model, strategy etc..
- Attend the concluding celebration where students pitch their ventures to their peers, coaches, mentors, and a group of investors - as you have interest.
